Ross Robinson

After years of playing in bands and working at studios, Ross Robinson used his experience to help develop a young, unsigned band called Korn. He produced and mixed their debut album, which sold over 2 million copies in the US.

For a lot producers, that might be the pinnacle of their career. But three years later, Ross achieved the same success with the unsigned band, Limp Bizkit, on their first album, which also sold 2 million copies in the US.

And two years after that, he did it a third time with the debut album from Slipknot which sold 2 million copies. He produced At The Drive-In's biggest album, as well as successful albums for The Cure, Sepultura, Glassjaw, Machine Head, and others. Altogether, albums that Ross produced have sold over 15 million copies.

Sales are only one measure of success, though. Another consideration is whether the artists enjoyed the process. The fact that many of the bands Ross has worked with have come back to work with him on subsequent albums suggests that, not only can he make great records, but that he can nurture the artists in the process.
